



CONTINUING EDUCATION APPROVAL PROGRAM (CEAP)

Wisconsin Nurses Association is accredited as an approver of nursing continuing professional development by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.

WNA CEAP IEA Applicants: Required 60-day post-session reporting

- ANCC requires information from all IEA activities to be entered in the Nursing Activity Record System (“NARS”).
- Applicants must enter required information about their activity in an online WNA information collection tool which is used by WNA to meet ANCC reporting requirements.
- For single activities, enter the information 60 days after the activity takes place.
- For single activities that are repeated one or more times for different audiences, enter the information 60 days after each time the activity is repeated.
- For a “regularly scheduled series” such as hospital case conferences, contact WNANPRL@wisconsinnurses.org for when to enter this information.
