I am aware of the Incapacitation legislation, unfortunately, we can only provide a second signature on those whose POA-HC documents have been updated to include APRNs. Another issue that I want to make you aware of is that of the CMS rules for face to face visits for DME and home health care. Only physicians are allowed to do these virtually, in spite of the fact that APRNs are the ones most often caring for our SNF patients and discharging them to home or ALFs. Because of this, I have to physically round at multiple SNFs, potentially exposing my patients and myself to infectious diseases. This has only become an issue with Covid-19, but I am fearful for the upcoming flu/Covid season.

I greatly appreciate the legislative updates.
