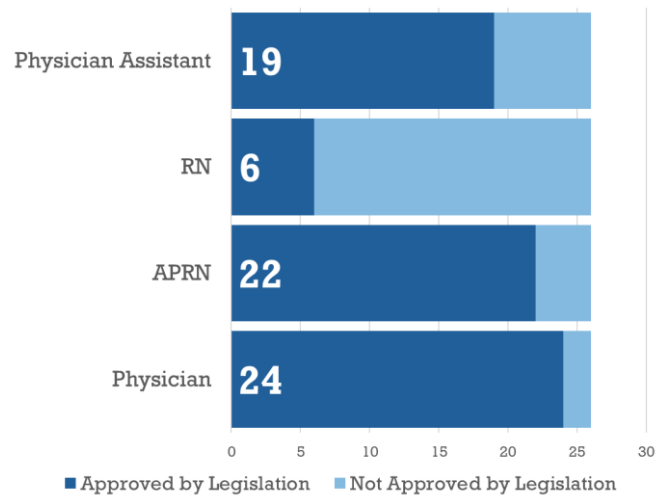


Tax Credit for Preceptors of Nursing Students and Employees

States with Tax Credits by License



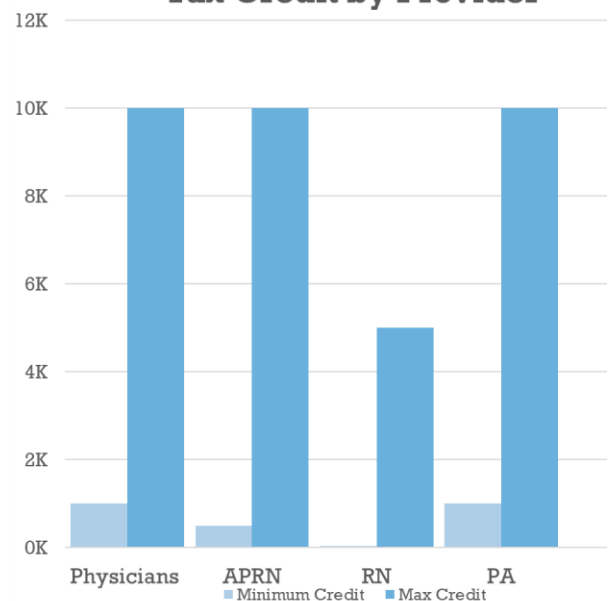
Preceptors are essential in assisting nursing students, novice nurses and experienced nurses to new areas of practice.

Preceptors successfully transition the nursing student and novice from the classroom to the clinical setting.

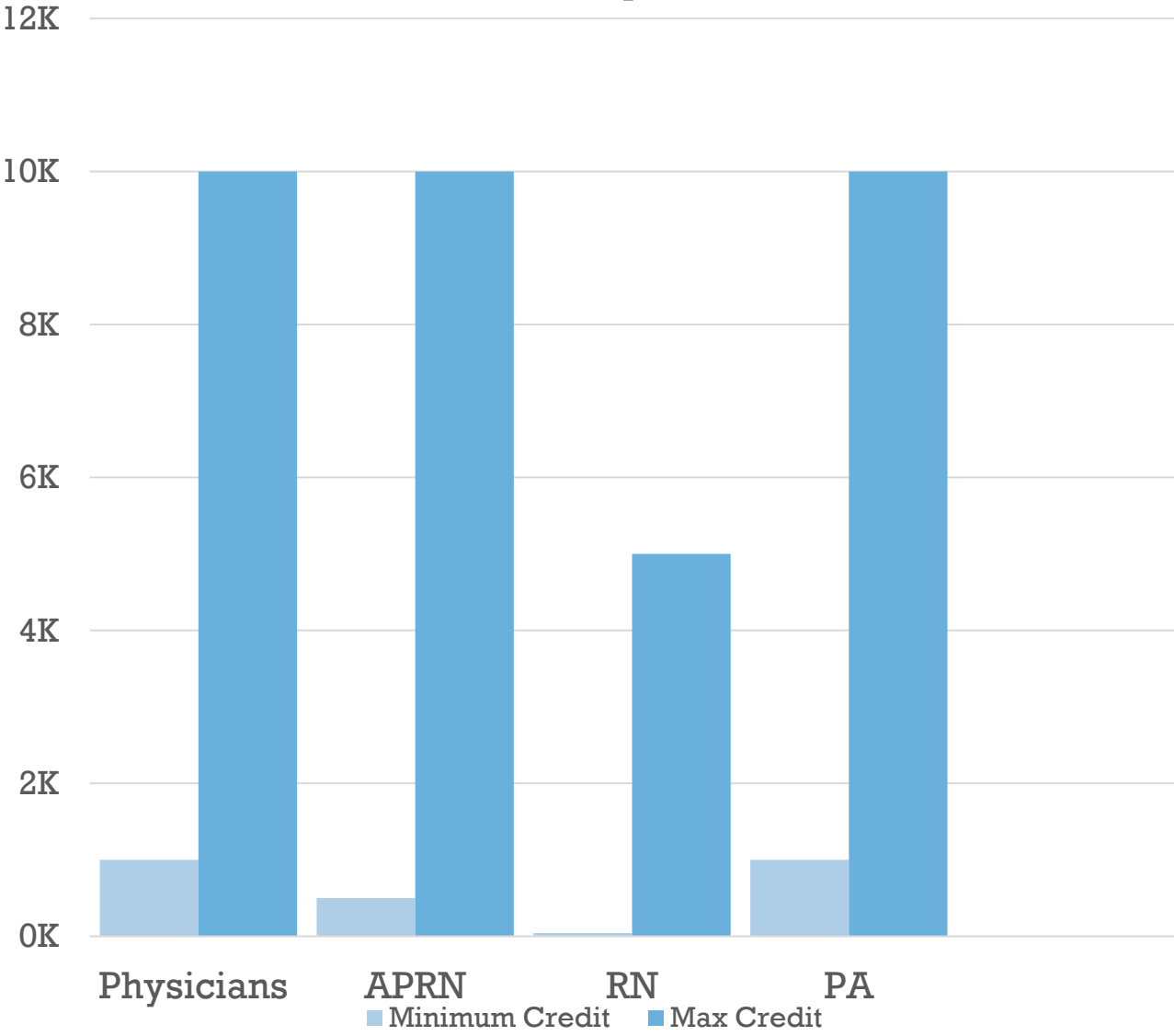
Preceptors significantly contribute to nurses' competencies, environmental awareness, professional growth, and success.

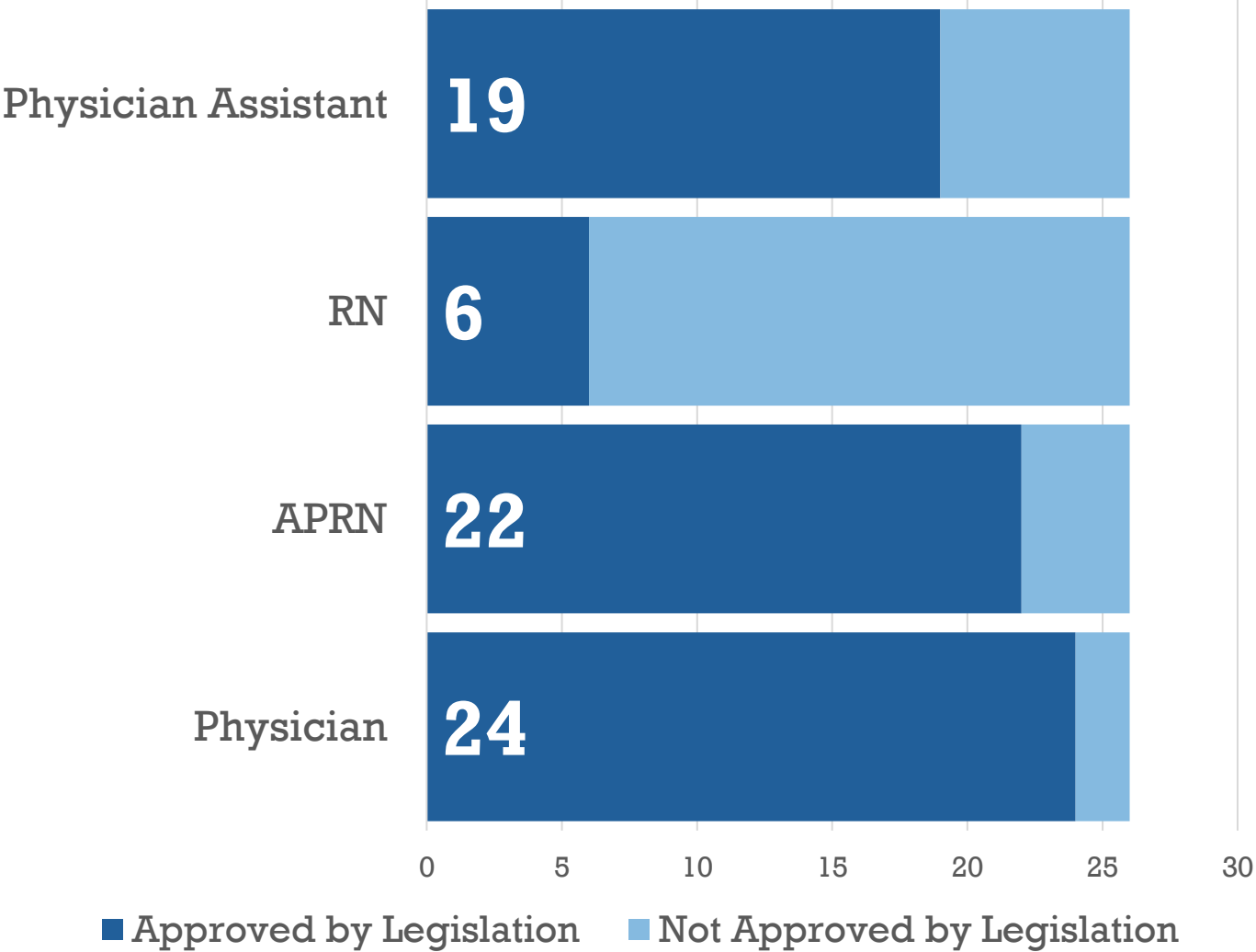


Request: Adopt legislation that provides all nurses, RN and APRNs eligibility for an annual Tax Credit

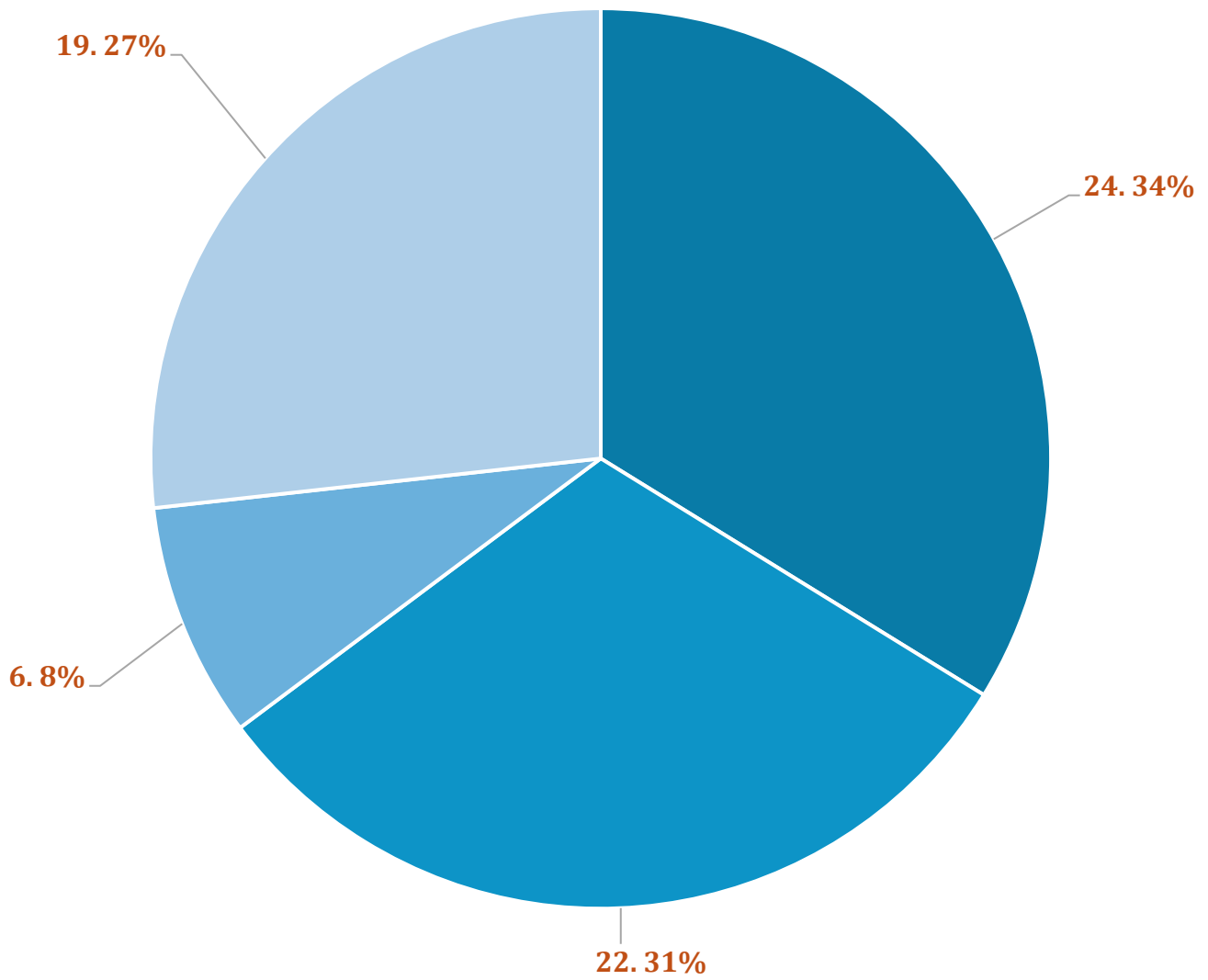
Tax Credit by Provider
