

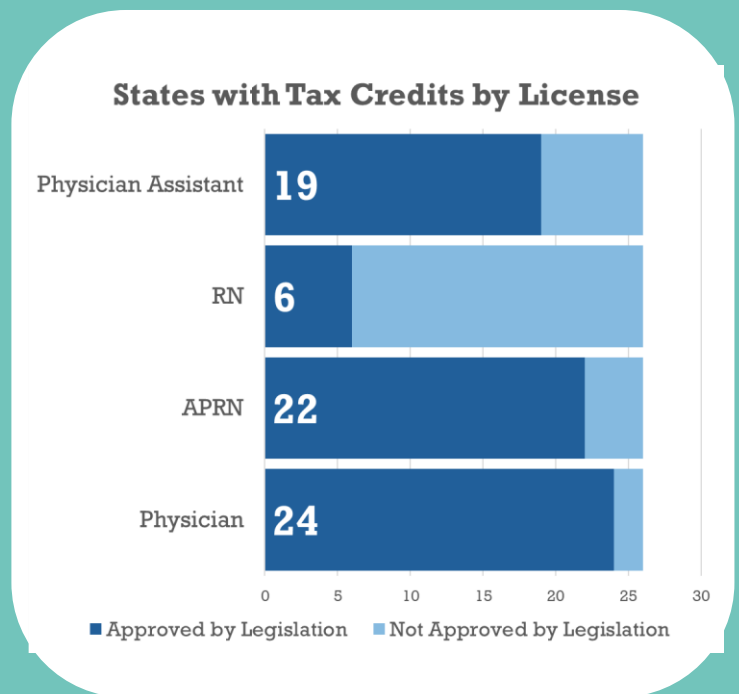
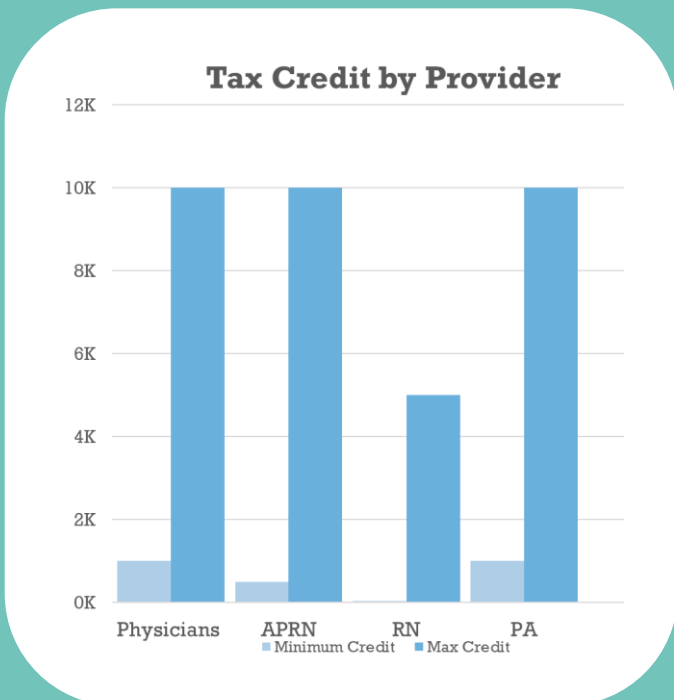
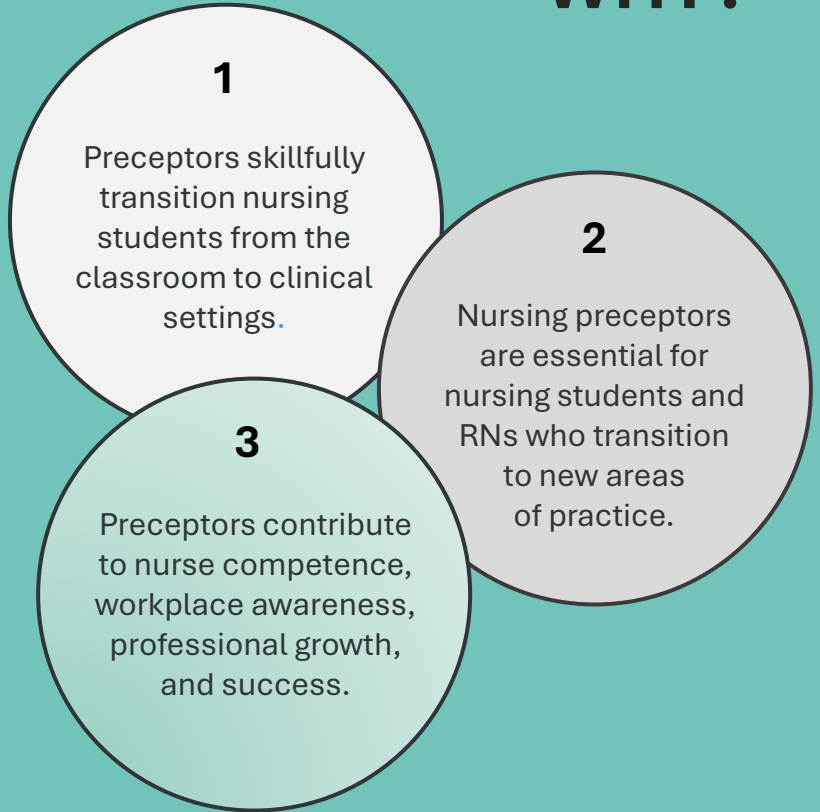


TAX CREDIT for Nurse Preceptors – WHY?

The RN and APRN nursing preceptor role includes: educator, evaluator, and protector plus provider of guidance, support, and mentorship.

Nurse precepting is challenging, and the responsibilities occur simultaneously with the demands of clinical practice. No additional compensation is offered, patient loads aren't decreased, and dedicated time for responsibilities specific to being an RN or APRN preceptor is not available.

Nurses who are preceptors are beneficial to growing the nursing workforce and deserve recognition.
